



## Pilgrims Hatch Ward Councillors Vicky Davies, Barry Aspinell and David Kendall



Councillor Barry Aspinell says.... "I've put this leaflet together to inform you all of the planning application that has been received by Brentwood Council which, under the current planning legislation, needs a response from local residents by the 21st June, 2018.

The Council's Planning Officers have up to 13 weeks to make their recommendation following consultation with outside agencies, such as the Environment Agency, Essex County Highways, Essex and Suffolk Water, Anglian Water, the Fire Service and local residents. I cannot give any of you my personal view or opinion on this application as I am a substitute member for the planning committee and as such I am prohibited under law to do so. Otherwise, I am considered 'fettered' and will not be able to speak or vote at the committee stage when this application comes forward.

My two ward colleagues, Vicky Davies and David Kendall, have already fettered themselves by attending a residents meeting and committing themselves against this green belt application. I will be attending the meeting planned for Friday and I have asked the officers at Brentwood to supply me with a hard copy of the planning application and an area map clearly showing the application site boundaries. I will be able to explain the planning process, the timelines we will be working to and what our roles will be by the time the application comes to committee. Both Vicky and David have what is termed 'Ward Member Rights' and will be able to speak for the residents at the committee stage.

If anyone wishes further information, please do not hesitate to contact Vicky, David or myself and in the meantime I look forward to meeting those of you who will be attending on Friday."
